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DESCRIPTION OF THE SAMPLE

The material is available in brown glass bottles containing 10 mg. The CRM corresponds to the original CRM BCR-177 (100 mg), which was re-packaged under clean and inert gas conditions. The identity between BCR-177 and BCR-177R has been demonstrated using differential scanning calorimetry (DSC).
