This Standard Reference Material (SRM®) is a commercial crude oil intended for use in the evaluation of methods and the calibration of instruments used in the determination of total sulfur, mercury, and water in crude oil or materials of a similar matrix. The light-sour Texas crude oil used for this SRM® was passed through a 10 µm filter and blended before being ampouled.
