Lead has a variety of uses, dependent upon its purity and/or the elements that it is alloyed with. Antimony (Sb) is often added to improve hardness and strength, and Pb with 6% Sb specifically has a variety of uses, from sheets intended for use in the chemical industry, to piping used in plumbing and water distribution.
