Category: Aromatics, Peptides, Pharmaceuticals, Intermediates and Fine Chemicals /// Appearance: Off-White to Brown Solid /// Application Notes: Alamethicin is a peptide antibiotic, produced by the fungus *Trichoderma viride*. Alamethicin contains the non-proteinogenic amino acid 2-aminoisobutyric acid (Aib), which strongly induces helical peptide structures.
