Appearance: White to Off-White Solid /// Application Notes: L-alloisoleucine is a stereo-isomer of L-isoleucine (1820175) and is produced as a byproduct of isoleucine via transamination. L-allo-isoleucine has been suggested to induce epithelial beta-defensin expression.
